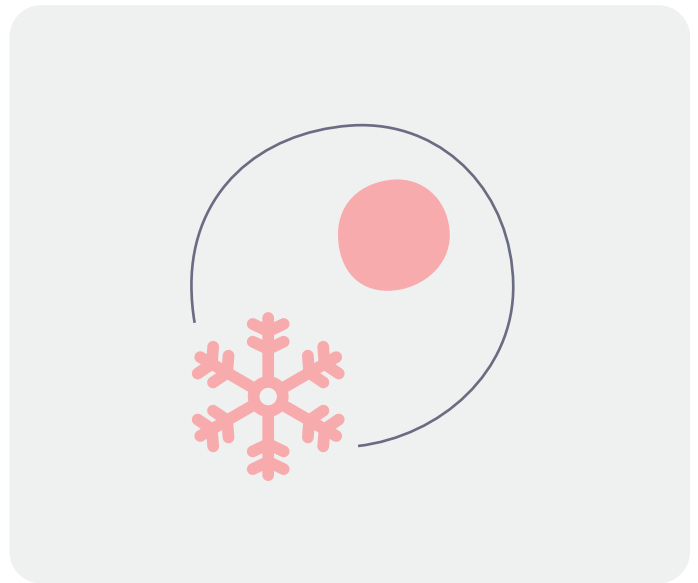

## Egg Freezing Programme

Egg freezing (cryopreservation of mature oocytes) is a very good way to stop the biological clock in case of social, personal and professional reasons when a woman decides to postpone the birth of a child. It gives the possibility to conceive one's own child in a wider timeframe.

The key factor for successful egg freezing is age. As age increases, both the number of eggs and their quality decrease. Egg stocks begin to decline more rapidly around the age of 37. If you are 43 years old, most eggs do not have the potential for pregnancy.

Collecting eggs and storing them for future use (called cryopreservation) may also give you the best chance of conceiving later if you are facing a medical procedure or treatment where damage to your ovaries may occur. Women with cancer that requires chemotherapy and/or radiation to the pelvis are highly likely to have their fertility affected. Freezing eggs before undergoing treatment is always a smart choice.

## What is the procedure for freezing eggs?

While freezing eggs is a multi-step process, it's much easier than you might think.

1. You will self-administer two to three hormonal medications over a period of 10-12 days. (These medications will stimulate your ovaries to produce multiple eggs in one menstrual cycle instead of the one egg produced in a normal cycle.
2. To monitor the development of your eggs during this period, you will also undergo several pelvic ultrasound scans and blood tests.
3. Once your eggs have matured, you will undergo ultrasound-guided outpatient surgery to retrieve them. The outpatient procedure takes 20-30 minutes under anesthesia. Therefore, the procedure does not hurt. Although rest is recommended, many clients are able to return to work the following day.
4. Immediately after collection, your follicular fluid will be transported to our embryology lab where your eggs will be retrieved and isolated in preparation for freezing.
5. At Europe IVF, we use only the best technology. This means we use a flash freezing technique called vitrification, which dehydrates and freezes the eggs instantly, ensuring the best survival rate when thawed. The eggs are stored in liquid nitrogen tanks in the embryology lab.
6. Once you are ready to use the eggs, they are fully available to you for either IVF at our clinic or, if you move, they will be transferred to another tissue center.

Frozen eggs can be stored for many years without significant deterioration. When a woman is ready to use the eggs, they are warmed and then fertilized with sperm. The goal is for the fertilized egg to develop into an embryo, which can then be transferred into the woman's uterus, giving her a chance to become pregnant.
